

# **Step-by-step guide For Holcim Green Built Bangladesh Contest 2009-10**

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## **Holcim Green Built Bangladesh (HGBB)**

- **Holcim Bangladesh Ltd**, a company under the umbrella of Holcim Group, is very much aspired in bringing Sustainable Green Construction concept in Bangladesh. Based on the global concept of triple bottom line – value creation, sustainable environmental performance and social responsibility **Holcim Bangladesh** promises to create awareness in Bangladesh towards the ultimate goal of achieving a **Green Built Culture in the Country**.
- **Vision:** To make “Green Built Bangladesh” a reality.
- **Mission:** To create a culture of sustainable development by promoting the concept of “Green Built Bangladesh”, catering to the needs of our present and future generations.
- **Objectives:**
  - Non-commercial promotion and development of the culture to take the country towards Green Construction
  - To unite diverse ranges of experts and increase awareness of the critical role of green construction for sustainable development
  - Inspire engineers, architects, planners, developers and contractors to adopt new Green Construction parameters for all their building projects
  - To initiate the steps in developing a sustainable green construction for the society

## **Competition Category**

- The competition will be held in two categories –
  - **Built Projects:** The projects that are already constructed, under construction or are approved for construction.
  - **Idea Projects:** These are idea generating or research-oriented projects that can also be conceptual visions (even with a low potential for immediate realization).

## Prize Money

The total prize money allotted for “**Holcim Green Built Bangladesh**” contest is BDT 20 lacs. A portion of the Prize money will be equally distributed for both the categories and the remaining amount will be kept as special prizes. The Advisory Board, on the recommendations of the Jury may not award prize in any of the categories above if suitable meritorious entries are not received.

## Juries

The jury board that will evaluate and rank the entries, comprises of leading and renowned architects, engineers, planners and artists of the society.

## **Participation**

- There will be two categories of projects – Built Projects and Idea Projects. Submitted designs will demonstrate proof of sustainability for Green Construction.
- The major criteria for evaluation of entries are explained in details in the outline given separately.
- The jury may exclude projects that do not meet the guidelines laid down in this document.

## **Eligibility**

Each participant should fulfill the following criteria –

All Bangladeshi Citizens above the age of 18 years are eligible for this Contest. As a proof, photocopy of National ID Card, passport or any other acceptable proof of citizenship can be submitted.

Entries in the competition may be submitted by the project’s design team, which consists of the author(s) and all other persons responsible for the project. Eligible for participation are private or public promoters/investors or architects/planners/engineers involved in the Project, providing that they hold the right of authorship or are participating in agreement with the person(s) holding the right of authorship. Legal entities and design teams must name an authorized representative who will act as the responsible contact person (“Main Author”). The statements made in entry form are considered to be true and legally binding in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. Every author is required to individually clarify his or her eligibility for participation. The eligibility of the authors will be re-checked before prizes are conferred. Entries to the Idea Projects competition may only be submitted by the project’s design team, which consists of the author(s) and all other persons responsible for the project. In case of group projects the details of Project Leader should be clearly marked. The distribution of the prize money will be under the responsibility of the Project Leader, the organizer – Holcim (Bangladesh) is not responsible for distribution of the prize money among the group members, whose project is awarded.

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## **Impediments / conflict of interest**

Ineligible for participation are those who, due to their collaboration in the preparation or running of the competition, might be in a favored position, able to influence the jury’s decision or have any other (matured or not matured) conflict of interest. This concerns, in particular, all jurors, examiners and guests as well as their spouses, first- and second-

degree relatives or in-laws and their permanent business or project partners and the immediate superiors and collaborators of ineligible persons. Holcim staff members are not eligible for taking part in this competition.

## **Consent**

By virtue of their participation in or by contribution to the competition, all parties including participants, jurors and examiners declare their consent to the present conditions. By contributing to the competition, entrants agree to accept the decision of the respective jury as final. There is no right of appeal and no participant shall have recourse to any national or international court of law.

## **Ownership and copyright**

Although the right of authorship, including protection against the copying of ideas, and the right to publication of the design remains with each author, the latter explicitly grants the Holcim Bangladesh Ltd the right to use the data, documents and files submitted in its entirety or partly, internally or externally in every form and for any purpose like publications, exhibitions, inclusion in web-site etc in relation to the Holcim Green Built Bangladesh competition.

## **Submission Mode**

Submitted projects will be accepted in printed format and digital submission in a CD is required. Both the formats are mandatory. The submission should be restricted to four A2 size sheets.

All entries will be submitted at the Corporate Headquarters of Holcim (Bangladesh) at the address given below. The entries can be sent by mail or by hand. For entries sent by mail the contestants must make sure that they are properly packed in appropriate covers and the organizers are not responsible for any damage in transit or post. The envelope containing the entry documents must be marked in Bold with the title “Holcim Green Built Bangladesh”.

### ***Statements about the project's relation to the target issues for Green Construction***

A concise statement exemplifying your project's contribution to meeting target issues and particular criteria should be given at the place earmarked in the Contest Form.

### ***Affidavit of Originality***

An affidavit of Originality would be signed by the participant or the Project Leader (for Group Project) as per the format given in the Contest application form.
